



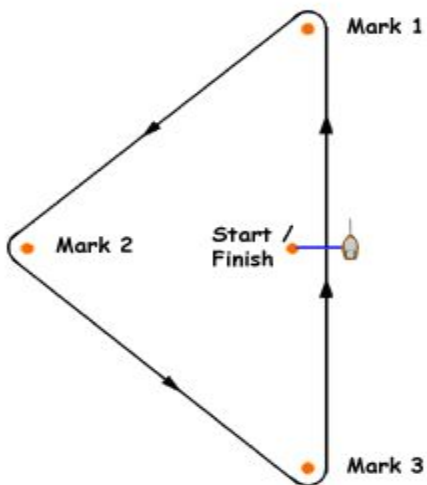

Sailing Instructions

1. **Rules:** This regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020, the prescriptions of US Sailing and Club 420 Classes, the Notice of Race, except as any of these are changed by the sailing instructions.
2. **Notice to the Competitors:** will be posted on the official regatta notice board of the Ram Island Yacht Club.
3. **Fee:** \$20.00 per sailor.
 - 4.1: Lunch will **NOT** be provided. Please bring your own lunch and water bottle.
 - 4.2: Trophies and give away provided.
4. **Schedule:** One race makes the event a regatta
8:30-9:15 Registration and Check-in.
9:30 Skippers Meeting
10:00 Harbor Start
No Race will start after 3:30pm
5. **Protests:** Boats protesting will act according to RRS 61 except as modified in these sailing instructions. Upon finishing the race, you must tell the race committee whom you are protesting. You must deliver your protest to the race committee within 30 minutes of the RC boat docking.
6. **Safety:** Each competitor must wear a USCG approved PFD, properly secured at all times while on the water.
7. **The Start:** At three minutes the class flag will be flown for the class that is to start- numeral pennant 4 for 420s and code flag J for Blue Jays. Three- minute dingy starts will be used.
8. **Recalls** – Individual Recalls: will be signaled by Flag “X” and one sound signal. The race committee will attempt to hail the sail number of any boats over early. Failure to hear a hail shall not be considered ground for redress. General Recall will be signaled with two horn blasts and the first repeater will be hoisted. After a General Recall the one-minute (around the ends) rule will be in effect.
9. **Time Limit** for the first boat to finish will be 60 minutes. Those boats that do not finish within 30 minutes of the first boat in their division will be scored DNF. At the discretion of the Race Committee, the race may be abandoned if it seems futile. The Race Committee may also give boats their position in order to

expedite the regatta.

10. **Scoring:** Low Point System, Appendix A of the racing Rules of Sailing, will be used. If 6 races are sailed, the worst score will be dropped.
11. **Support Craft Spectator boats** shall stay clear of the race area(s) at all times and stay outside of the course area. Coaching may occur only between races, up to the warning signal and well clear of the finishing area and any boats still on the course.
12. **Course:** The course letter will be posted on the committee boat. Marks will be orange inflatable shapes. The start and finish marks will either be an orange ball or a stake boat. The line will be sighted from the orange flag on the Committee boat and the mast on the stake boat if it is used.
